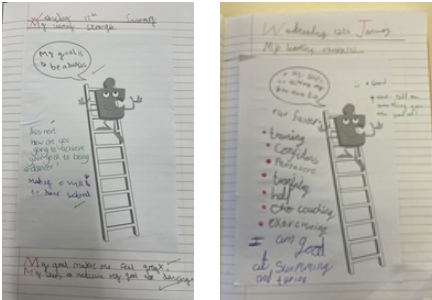

The children have been thinking about their goals and dreams in PSHE this week.



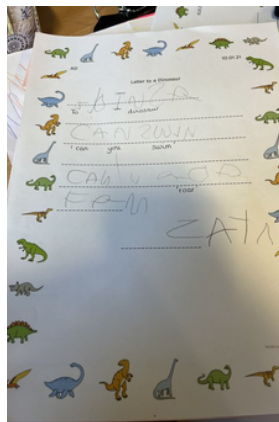
## WORK HARD

Deadline for applications is **15th January 2022**.

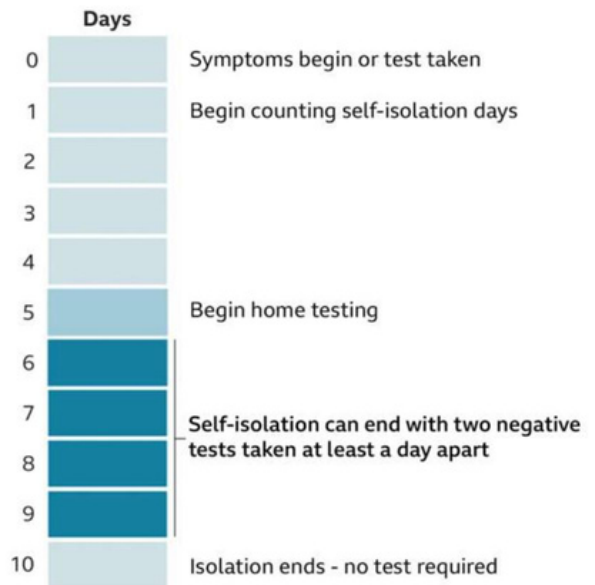
