Please be reminded that the After School Activity Clubs will finish on Friday 16th December. Only the Morning Club will run on 19th, 20th and 21st December.

Booking will open for the Morning Club sessions for the first half of the Spring Term on MONDAY 12th DECEMBER 2022 at 6pm. Payments will need to be made through the Arbor app when you book your sessions. The cost will be £2 per session. Please only book the sessions your child actually needs to attend, as block booking can prevent other children from attending due to our limited number of spaces. If you need to cancel a booked Morning Club session, you will need to contact to school office giving a minimum of 24 hours notice.

From January, there will be a small charge (£7.50 for 5 sessions) for the After School Clubs. Please book your child's place on Arbor for the first half of the Spring Term. Payment for the clubs will need to be made through the Arbor app when you sign your child up. All clubs start at 3.10pm and finish at 4.10pm.
