Summer Reading:

Please ensure that reading takes place every night for at least 20minutes as we are having a huge focus on daily reading and comprehension! Reading journals have been given out this week, communication between parents and teachers will ensure progress for the children. Take a look at the website supplied for age appropriate reading- including all genres.

Ask your child questions about the plots of the stories they read, which characters they like and why, and what they have learnt from the books they have read; why they have/haven't enjoyed them

Maths:

The children are encouraged to continue to learn all their times tables as they will be tested every week on different numbers as well as a mental maths test of the weeks work. Year 3 expectations are to cover all of the 12 times tables.

We have looked briefly at (Place Value) and will continue this with estimating and rounding numbers.
