

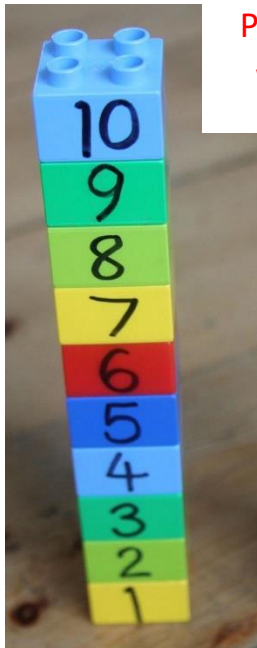
Summer Holiday Activities

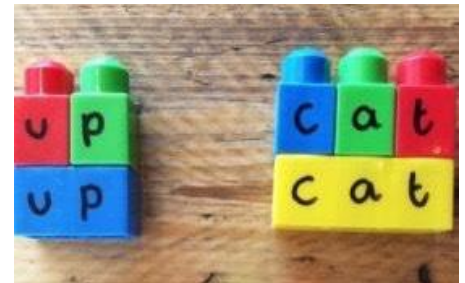
Practice recognising and writing numbers to 10

- I enjoy exploring new things/places.

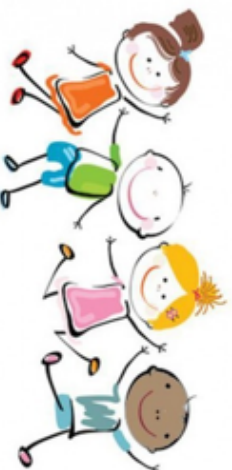
Communication and language
