The leaves are falling from the trees, from the trees from the trees. The leaves are falling from the trees, its Autumn time.

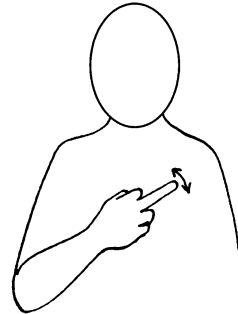

QUESTION FOR YOUR CHILD

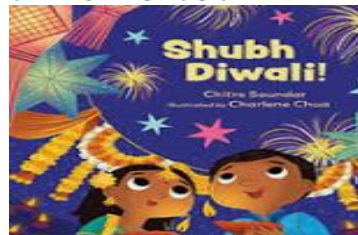
Do you share with your friends?
