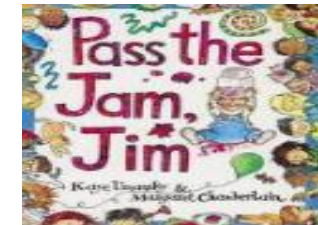

SONG OF THE WEEK

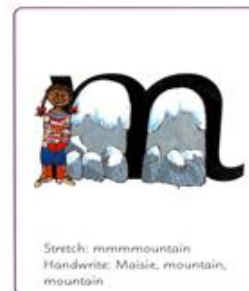
Five currant buns in a baker's shop
