at home.



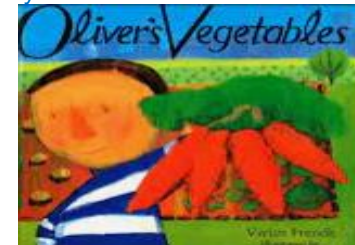

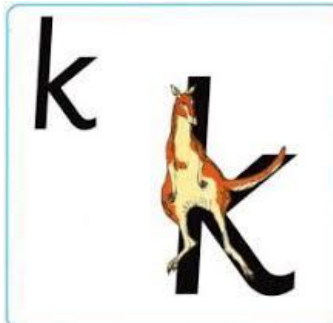


SONG OF THE WEEK
