Please can we ask that you make sure that all your children's clothes have their names on, this makes it easier to find.

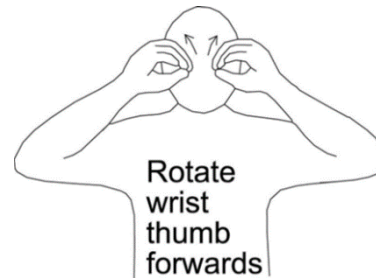
We will be beginning to learn our song for harvest celebration over the coming weeks. It is 'dingle dangle scarecrow'.

LITERACY FOCUS

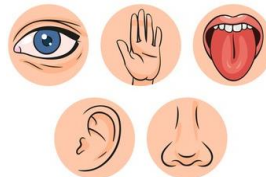
We will be reading the story of Owl Babies this week.

Throughout the week, we will be retelling the story using puppets and looking at how we can make owls in different ways eg. Collage, playdough.

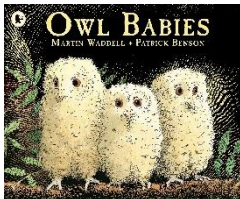
Key Vocabulary: Owl, Mum, Baby, Branch
