Throughout the week, we will looking at how people celebrate these events. We will also look at firework safety.

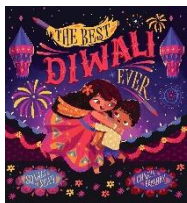
**Key Vocabulary: celebrations, fireworks, bonfire night, Diwali.**
