And the dish ran away with the spoon!

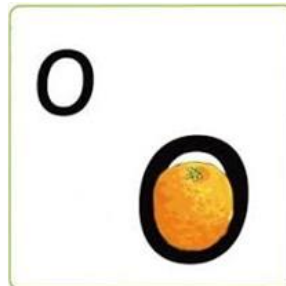

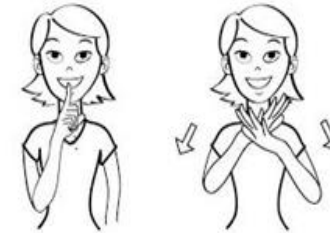

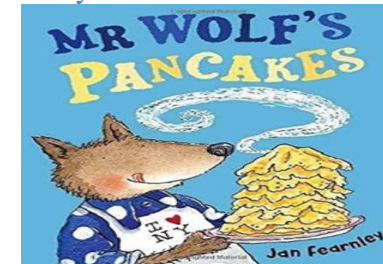
