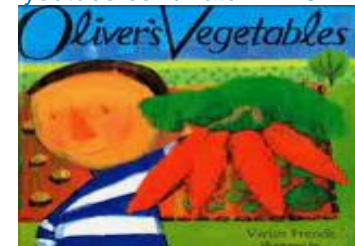

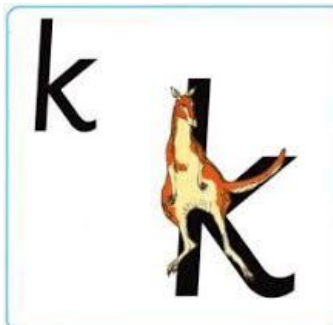


### SONG OF THE WEEK
