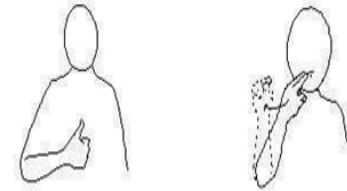
THEME OF THE WEEK
