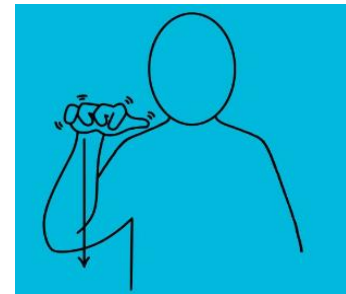
### THEME OF THE WEEK

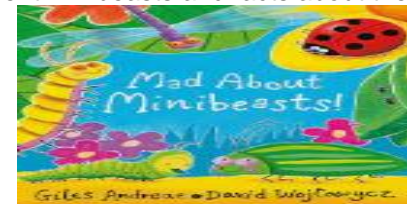
b-b-b boot
