THEME OF THE WEEK

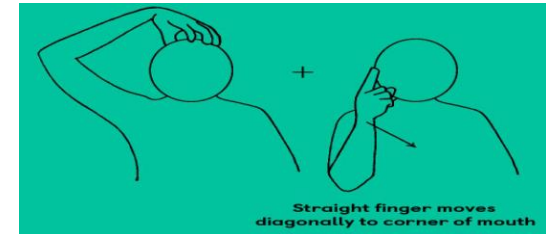
The Queen's Platinum Jubilee
