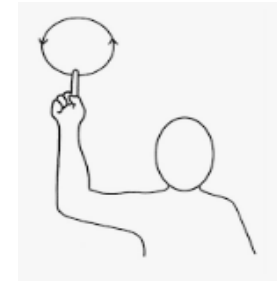
THEME OF THE WEEK

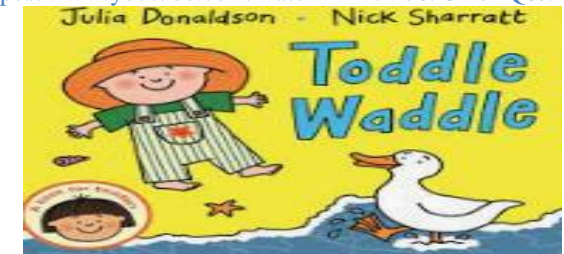
